Patients can access free treatment monitoring via the UK Medical Cannabis Registry and understand how medical cannabis may impact different aspects of your health.


The registry, the first of its kind in the UK, was set up as recommended by NHS England and captures essential data including how effective the medicine is at treating your symptoms and any side effects you develop.
